ABOUT NAMCHI – SIKKIM

Namchi, the charming district of Sikkim, is much more than just a scenic hill town—it's a vibrant blend of spirituality, culture, and eco-tourism. Located approximately 75 kilometers from Gangtok and 90 kilometers from Siliguri, Namchi has grown into one of the most popular destinations in the Eastern Himalayas. Namchi is fast becoming a tourist spot and pilgrimage centre.

Spanning around 75,000 hectares, Namchi district is the 3rd smallest in Sikkim by area but the second most populous. The region's diverse topography ranges from 400 meters to 2,000 meters above sea level, featuring terraced agricultural fields, spring-fed forests, and scenic hills. The climate is temperate, with average temperatures ranging from 2°C to 27°C and an annual rainfall of 162.5 cm.

• OUR LAND & HISTORY

Namchi's name comes from the Bhutia words "Nam" (sky) and "Chi" (high), meaning "Sky High." True to its name, the town rests amidst lofty hills, where clouds seem within arm's reach. Historically, it was a small settlement of the Bhutia and Lepcha tribes. Today, it thrives as a peaceful urban town that celebrates Sikkim's multicultural harmony—blending traditions of Buddhism, Hinduism, and local customs.

• SPIRITUAL & CULTURAL HUB

Namchi is home to some of the most significant religious landmarks in Sikkim. The iconic Siddhesvara Dham (Char Dham) is a unique pilgrimage site featuring replicas of India's four most sacred temples along with a towering 87-ft statue of Lord Shiva. Just a short drive away, the Samdruptse Hill hosts a 45-meter tall golden statue of Guru Padmasambhava, offering spiritual solace and panoramic views.



• CUISINE

Sikkim's cuisine is influenced by its diverse communities. Momo (dumplings) and Thukpa (noodle soup) are popular local dishes. Other staples include Phagshapa (pork with radish), Chhurpi (a local cheese), and a variety of rice-based dishes.

• POLITICAL HISTORY

Sikkim was an independent kingdom until it became a state of India in 1975. Prior to this, it was a monarchy under the Chogyal dynasty. The state has a significant history of activism and political changes, including the merger with India following a referendum in 1975.

• ENVIRONMENT INITIATIVES

Sikkim is a leader in environmental conservation and sustainable tourism. It was the first state in India to achieve 100% organic farming, and its commitment to environmental protection has earned it numerous accolades. It also bans plastic bags and has initiatives aimed at preserving its natural resources and maintaining eco-tourism standards.

Sikkim's tranquility, natural beauty, and cultural richness make it a unique place to visit. If you're interested in nature, adventure, or simply seeking peace away from urban life, Sikkim offers a perfect getaway.

TOURIST ATTRACTIONS

- **NATHULA PASS** : A strategic mountain pass that connects India to Tibet, offering stunning views of the surrounding snow capped mountains.
- **PELLING**: A beautiful town offering views of Khangchendzonga and close to attractions like the Pemayangtse monastery.
- **YUKSOM**: Known as the gateway to Khangchendzonga, this town is rich in history and culture.
- **TSONGMO LAKE (CHANGU LAKE)** : A high-altitude glacial lake that is a popular spot for sightseeing and photography.
- **SIDDHESHWAR DHAM (CHARDHAM)**: Located atop Solophok Hill, this complex features replicas of four major Hindu temples and a 108-foot statue of Lord Shiva.
- **SAMDRUPTSE MONASTERY**: Home to the world's tallest statue of Guru Padmasambhava, this monastery is a significant spiritual site.
- **MAENAM WILDLIFE SANCTUARY**: A haven for nature enthusiasts, this sanctuary is rich in medicinal plants and home to diverse wildlife.
- **TEMI TEA GARDEN**: The only tea estate in Sikkim, offering visitors a chance to explore tea cultivation and enjoy scenic views.
- **BHAICHUNG BHUTIA FOOTBALL STADIUM**: A modern sports facility named after India's first footballer to play 100 international matches.

Namchi is also known for Temi Tea Garden, the only tea estate in Sikkim, famous worldwide for producing high-quality organic tea. The lush green tea gardens spread across gentle hills not only offer stunning landscapes but also support sustainable eco-tourism and rural livelihoods.

The town comes alive during festivals like Namchi Mahotsav, where local artisans, performers, and chefs display Sikkim's traditional arts, music, and cuisine. Namchi also acts as a gateway for trekkers, birdwatchers, and nature lovers who wish to explore the Maenam Wildlife Sanctuary, Tarey Bhir, and nearby villages like Ravangla and Borong. With pleasant weather year-round, Namchi offers the perfect balance of exploration and relaxation.

(ACT NO. 09 OF 2023)

to provide for the establishment and incorporation of the Sikkim Global Technical University in the State of Sikkim, and to confer the status of a Private University thereon and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

WHEREAS, with a view to provide major boost in terms of academic upliftment in all spheres of knowledge it is essential to impart education in almost all areas including Management, Engineering, Law, Information Technology & Communication, Medical, Nursing, Insurance, Behavioural Science, Fine Arts, etc. to the youth at their doorsteps;

AND WHEREAS, Indira Gandhi Computer Saksharta Mission registered under Indian Trust Act, 1882 has having registration number no. 4624 registered on 17th September, 2008 by sub-register Government of NCT, New Delhi, Government of India;

NOW THEREFORE, Indira Gandhi Computer Saksharta Mission (IGCSM) intends to establish Sikkim Global Technical University in the State of Sikkim with the objective to provide Higher Education with skilled and entrepreneur courses in Sikkim through world class infrastructure and international networking which shall catalyse not only the surrounding region but the State as a whole.

BE it enacted by the Legislature of Sikkim in the Seventy-fourth Year of the Republic of India, as follows:

This has reference to the Sikkim Global Technical University Act, 2023 (Act No.9 of 2023), Notification issued by the Govt. of Sikkim and a duly notarised Affidavit/Undertaking vide Certificate No. IN-DL35675226610531W dated 30.01.2024 sent by the university regarding the establishment of University. In this regard, it is to be informed that as per the Sikkim Global Technical University Act, 2023 (Act No.9 of 2023), the Sikkim Global Technical University, Link Road, Bhutia Basti, District, Namchi, Opp. to Reliance, Sikkim - 737126 has been established as a State (Private) University by the Government of Sikkim with effect from 01.08.2023 and notified vide Notification No. 48//DIR (HE)/EDN dated 14.09.2023. Accordingly, the name of the university has been included in the list of universities, as maintained by UGC under Section 2(f) of UGC Act, 1956. The list is available on the UGC website www.ugc.gov.in.

The University may note and adhere to the following:

1. The inclusion of the name of the University in the list of universities maintained by the UGC does not by itself allow the University to make admissions in its programmes. This may be done only after creation of required academic and physical infrastructure facilities, including library, laboratories and appointment of teaching and supporting staff as per the norms and standards laid down by the UGC and Statutory Council(s) concerned.
2. The University is requested to submit detailed information (soft copy only) in the prescribed format (available at UGC website at the link <https://www.ugc.gov.in/oldpdf/proformaprivateuniversities.pdf>) along with supporting documents duly attested by the Registrar of the University within a period of 3 months from the receipt of this letter. The University is also requested to upload the filled in format and appendices on its website by giving a link on the home page so that the information is accessible to the students and general public.



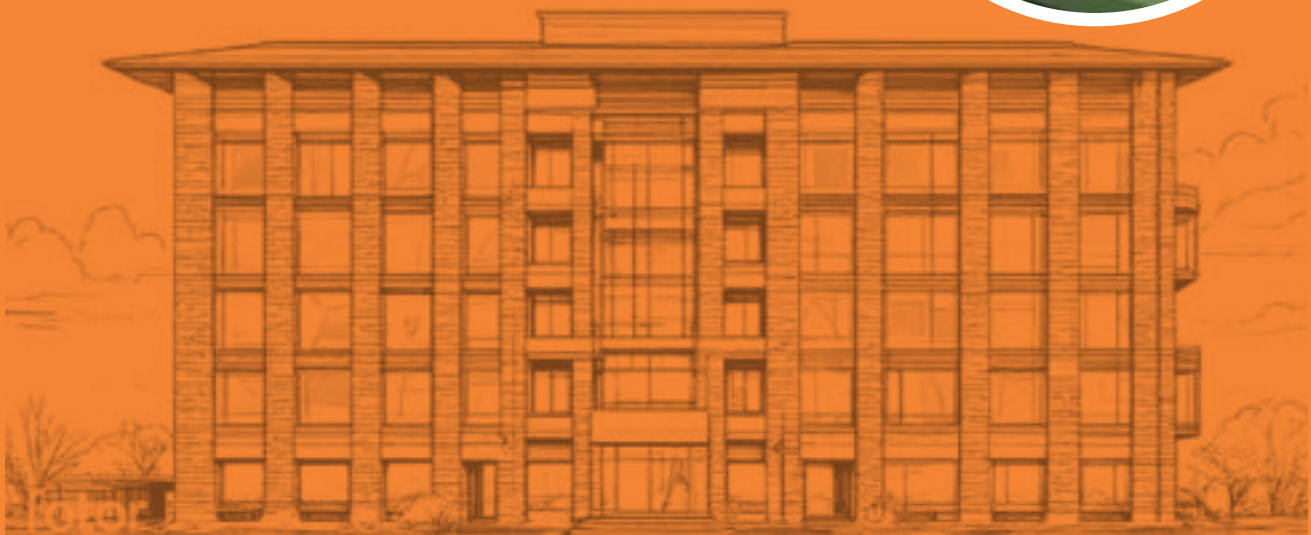
